**6. NATIONALITY/ CITIZENSHIP**

A candidate must be either:

- (a) A citizen of India, or
- (b) A subject of Nepal, or
- (c) A subject of Bhutan, or
- (d) A Tibetan Refugee who came over to India, before the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- (e) A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India .

**6.1.** Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (b), (c), (d) and (e) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.

**6.2.** A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the Examination but the offer of appointment will be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate issued to him by the Government of India.

**7. EXAMINATION FEE, EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF FEE AND MODE OF PAYMENT OF FEE:**

- (i) Fee payable: Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only).
- (ii) **FEE CAN BE PAID THROUGH SBI CHALLAN ONLY.**

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(iii) Fee paid through any other mode will NOT be accepted. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. Fee should be paid separately for each category of post applied.

(iv) Women candidates and candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Persons with Disabilities (PwD) and Ex-Servicemen (ExS) eligible for reservation, are exempted from paying application fee.

(v) The facility for submission of online application will be available from **05.09.2018 to 30.09.2018 (1700 Hours)**. Candidates are required to make the payment only through challan of SBI, at designated branches of SBI within the working hours of bank up to 03-10-2018 provided the challan has been generated by them before closing date and time for receipt of applications i.e. 30-09-2018 (1700 Hours).

(vi) Applications received without the prescribed fee shall not be considered and summarily rejected. No representation against such rejection will be entertained. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be adjusted against any other examination or selection.

## 10. CRUCIAL DATE FOR ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS (EQ) & AGE LIMIT:

- i. Essential Qualifications (EQs) & Age Limit for each Post as per the requirement of the concerned User Departments/ Ministries, are mentioned in the details/ description of Post(s) given in **Annexure-I** of this Notice.
- ii. The Crucial Date for determining of **AGE-LIMIT AND possession of ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION (EQs)/ EXPERIENCE will be 01.08.2018.**
- iii. Before applying for the post, the candidates must ensure that they possess the **ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS including Experience wherever it is prescribed as Essential Qualification and also meet the Age-Limit** as on the crucial date mentioned in Para 10(ii) above.
- iv.
