NOTICE

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, in its meeting held on 12-August-2015, has approved the proposal for strengthening of drug regulatory system both at the Central and the State levels at a total cost of Rs.1750 crore. Out of the total amount of Rs 1750 crore, an amount of Rs.900 crore will be spent on strengthening central structures and Rs.850 crore will be made available to the State Governments, after signing a Memorandum of Understanding.

Accordingly, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has prepared a format of Memorandum of Understanding required to be signed by the respective State Government and Government of India for implementation of the proposal of strengthening the States drug regulatory system.
